WELCOME TO SATURNA ISLAND, a lush paradise about 31 km² in the southern Gulf Islands chain. Saturna maintains some of the most beautiful rural and wilderness scenery in the Islands. The indigenous people called the island "Long Nose", after the long north-eastern tapering shoreline known as East Point. The name "Saturna" comes from the Spanish naval schooner Santa Saturnina captained by Jose Maria Narvaez who explored the island's coast in 1791. If you are looking for a natural wonder of unspoiled landscape as the backdrop for your next adventure, Saturna Island is it!
