

WELCOME TO SATURNA ISLAND, a green mountainous island about 31 km² in the Southern Gulf Islands chain. The indigenous people called the island “Long Nose”, due to the long north-eastern tapering shoreline. The name “Saturna” comes from the Spanish naval schooner *Santa Saturnina* captained by José María Narvaez who explored the island’s coast in 1791.

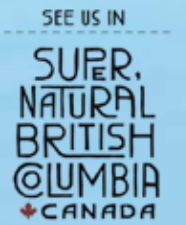
